<b>Brief description of the course:</b>	
<p>This course will equip you with basic conversation skills. You will learn to understand and use basic information about general travel e.g., understanding notices and announcements, requesting tickets, at a station, ferry terminal or an airport. You will also understand and use basic information about accommodation e.g., making bookings, providing basic requirements and prices.</p> <p>Although the course is delivered online, it is very practical, and there will be plenty of practice and role-play in pairs or groups.</p> <p>The assessments will also consist of role-play and simulations of simple everyday dialogues.</p>

Completion of French for Beginners Module 1 would be an advantage.
