Q2b Similar issues have arisen in earlier sessions. Is CCW content that the Plan is to be read as a whole and that the amendment is not needed?

Q2c Has the Background Paper suitably addressed the Representor's concerns?

Without a cross reference between Policies REG1 and SP7, a prospective developer for the site at SP7 (3) will not be aware that screening for a project level HRA will be required for any application at the site.

A cross reference is therefore required between the policies.

Q2d Unless there are cross references between Policies REG1 and SP7 would an SP7(3) waste facility developer be aware of all relevant considerations for the REG1(37) site including the potential impact on the SAC?
