

Dear Ellen Franks,

During the proposal period 11.11.2016 - 22.11.2016 we, a collective group of parents and concerned community members of Kenfig Hill have petitioned the community regarding the Proposal to Relocate Mynydd Cynffig Primary to the Cynffig Comprehensive Site.

Our physical petition did not begin until the 11.11 2016; as many of our community members were unaware of the proposal up until it was brought to light by a concerned parent on the 07.11.2016. From this date until now we have been gathering research, petitioning and attending proposal

During our petition we have become increasingly concerned at the number of community members that are unaware of the Councils intentions to move the amalgamated Primary school to the Comprehensive site.

In the short time that we have petitioned; 11 days in total we have gathered 11 arount of signatures.

These signatures pertain to the parents, guardians, grandparents and community members that have read the following research outlined in this document and have concerns regarding the proposal. Most of which we have outlined.

We also have an online petition running and the current number of signatures is

These petitions will continue to run until January where they will also be included as objections to the planning application; should the cabinet approve them.

Trends Of Concern Within The Community

We as a collective group of Parents, Guardians, Grandparents, Pupils and Community members would like to outline a list of trends that have been highlighted during this proposal period and would like the cabinet to take each factor into consideration:-

Environmental & Ecological

- More cars on the road due to parents preferring to drive rather than walk causing further congestion on the main roads of Kenfig Hill and through the Industrial Estate.
- Businesses in the local community will struggle due to a decrease in footfall.
- Dangers relating to the school entrance being relocated to the Industrial Estate
- Increased traffic to the East Avenue entrance
- HUGE CONCERN OVER THE PLANNING APPROVAL FOR A CONCRETE FACTORY WHICH IS TO BE LOCATED ADJECENT TO THE ATHLETICS FIELD
- Concern regarding the possible development for housing on the Junior and Infants sites
 once relocated to the Comp site and the adverse effects it will have on the community as a
 whole e.g. doctors, dentist, congestion, hospitals.

Health and Wellbeing

- Children will not be walking to school as it is too far away causing a rise in obesity
- Pressure on parents to walk their children to school regardless of the additional time it will take, and then having to get to work on time.
- Removal of milestones within a Childs development
- Negative impacts on the younger children observing adolescent behaviour e.g.
 Use of foul language
 Inappropriate hand signals
 Smoking

Sexual contact; kissing, heavy petting Observing teenage angst

Bullying

Community Impact

- Local businesses rely heavily on the footfall that the school generates as there is very little passing trade in Kenfig Hill.
- Senior citizens often come out to watch the Easter Bonnet Parade and other school activities allowing them time to socialise
- Removal of historical buildings within the community and memories that it holds for community members and generations of their family.
- Less social interaction between parents on the school yard due to the implementation of a 'drop off point'

We would like to make it known that WE as a collective object to the plans to move Mynydd Cynffig primary to the Cynffig Comprehensive site.

Formal Request To Extend The Proposal Period

As we understand the council/ cabinet are looking for trends within the concerns of the community hence the meetings with the public during this proposal period. However a large majority of the community have not been made aware of the proposed plans are therefore unaware of the meetings.

The times of the meetings are scheduled so that parents have been unable to attend due to work or after school commitments.

For these reasons trends cannot be accurately portrayed as you have only included a minority of the community in your current research.

We therefore formally request an extension of the proposal time from its minimum of 42 days to its maximum time limit. This will allow us a community to continue to gather further information and feed it back to the cabinet.

Further research we will be conducting includes: -

- Surveying the parents of the schools to project how many will resort to driving instead of walking to the new site. This allows us to accurately portray the environmental impact to the community.
- Contact local businesses to see what percentage of their business relies on the passing trade generated by the local schools.
- Spread word to the wider community allowing them to raise their own views on the project.
- Study the transport surveys that have outlined Cynffig Comprehensive as the preferred site for relocation, and look into why the Juniors site has been dismissed.
- Contact the Environmental Health and other relevant departments to see how the new Concrete Plant will affect the children once it is in situ; what methods they have in place to prevent air pollution and possible damage to health, who will be policing this etc.
- Continue our research into the effects that concrete plants have on the locals and children within a radius of the factory.
- Currently awaiting information from the Council on 'the right learning environment curricular opportunities particularly at the Foundation Phase' and where our current schools fall short on this.
- Possible impact on the local doctors surgery, dentist and other amenities should the Junior and Infants sites be developed for housing once they have become redundant.
- Further investigate the 'walking distance' for each child attending the proposed site to show that there is need for a provision of buses for younger children.
- We as a collective group would like to see the surveys and a list of 'serious concerns' that
 Highways have given to rule that this site is no longer the preferred location for the Primary
 School We have had meetings with Tony from Highways and other than worries over
 congestion at the lights, there has been no forthcoming answer.
- Ownership of the land for both the Juniors and Infants site we have been led to believe that both sites were donated by Mr Talbot of Margam Estate for Educational purposes and therefore neither belong to the council.

A Collective Response to the Consultation Document with Formal Requests for Answers

After reading the consultation document we would like to bring to your attention factors from your proposal document that need further investigation/ clarification:

Mynydd Cynffig Primary School

Consultation document 04.10.201

Page 4

"The distance between the existing Infant and Junior sites and the site for the proposed new Mynydd Cynffig Primary school are approximately 0.7 miles and 0.6 miles to the pedestrian entrance off East Avenue respectively."

You have calculated the distances from the Infant and Junior site, not from the locations that the children will be travelling from (their own homes) some of these children will be walking distances of 1.4miles, this is just outside of the 1.5mile distance that requires a bus to transport the children.

Page 4

"The proposed school would have a capacity of 420 pupils plus a nursery of 60 full time equivalent pupils."

"The current 4-11 capacity of the school is 345 with 360 pupils aged 4-11 on roll as at January 2016, resulting in 15 deficit places. The number on roll is projected to rise to 404 in 2024, which would mean that deficit places would be 59, should the school remain as current." (Found on Page 5)

According to these statistics there will be an increase of 60 spaces in the proposed school.

Your projected increase in students over an 8 year period (from 2016-2024) is 44 students. That is an average increase of 5.5 students every year.

Firstly we would like to know where these figures come from? Is it birth rate in the local community? Does it factor in new housing developments in the area?

Should the relocation of the Primary School go ahead, the sites of both Infants and Junior schools will become 'windfall' sites and will therefore be made available for housing development as is the trend in Bridgend County Borough (see appendix). Using your own calculations we could expect to see anywhere near 130-170 new houses built on these sites.

Using further calculations provided to us by Gaynor Thomas and Lucy Jones during the consultation meetings. To calculate the number of children per household a figure of 0.2 is used.

0.2 x 130 - 170 households - 26 - 34 additional children moving into the area

Was this equation calculated into following statement on page 4 of the Consultation Document?

"The number on roll is projected to rise to **404 in 2024**, which would mean that deficit places would be 59, should the school remain as current."

If it was.... it would mean that the figure quoted is misleading.

It would mean that you have taken into consideration a housing development that does not currently exist and that the increase to the school numbers on average, without the development of the Junior and Infants sites for housing could be between 14-18 students over an 8 year period. That means 1-2 additional students per year.

If this is the case, it is a VERY LARGE misrepresentation to the community and I call for further time to pass the correct details to the community.

If these figures HAVE NOT been included in the above statement it would mean that by 2024 there could be an additional 26-34 children attending the school due to the possible development of the Junior and Infants sites for housing.

"projected to rise to 404 in 2024,

PLUS A POSSIBLE ADDITION OF 26-34 CHILDREN = 430 - 438 CHILDREN IN THE SCHOOL

I quote from page 4 of the consultation document "The proposed school would have a capacity of 420 pupils plus a nursery of 60 full time equivalent pupils." this would mean that the proposed school would AGAIN be overpopulated and there would be no benefit for the upset you will have caused in the local community.

And again; if this is the case, it is a VERY LARGE misrepresentation to the community and I call for further time to pass the correct details to the community.

Page 5

"The school buildings across the two sites have a combined repairs and maintenance backlog of £616,265"

We as a collective would like to know what are the maintenance backlogs for other schools within the local area? And we would also like the 'overcrowding figures for all the schools in Bridgend County so that we may compare.

Pages 6&7

What are the advantages if the proposal goes ahead?

Allows all Mynydd Cynffig Primary pupils and staff to be located together on one site;

Granted, but this could be achieved on the Junior site as was originally set out in the plans that won over the parents to amalgamate the schools originally. Parents were not advised

that the school would be relocated to Cynffig Comrehensive and therefore the community feels it has been misled. Most have commented that they would never have allowed the amalgamation to go ahead/ would have protested had they known this was the end game.

Pupils and staff would benefit from remodelled and new provision;

Again this is a given, however the location of the proposed project is not accepted by the community.

Savings on repairs and maintenance expenditure of aging school buildings;

This could be achieved by building a new school on the Junior site.

Community provision could be incorporated into new school build;

From what we understand of this you mean that the community could rent space? or use facilities? This could easily have been included in the existing buildings had the local community been made aware that the facilities were available for hire. Birthday parties could have been held in the hall. 5 aside football teams or local sports clubs could have rented the fields and yards. When asked if this was an option we were advised it was not.

A school which is designed to provide the right learning environment curricular opportunities particularly at the Foundation Phase.

I have requested further information into this topic to see where our current schools fall short.

- Improved transition arrangements for pupils moving from primary to secondary education

 Logistically it is 'easier' to transition the child from Primary to Secondary school having them on the same site, but this could also be a negative factor in a Childs development as you are removing a high number of factors that help a child when it comes to life outside of school. By creating an environment where the child will effectively be contained within the same area/ have an unchanged environment from ages 3-18 you will reduce a large number of experiences from them, this could possibly have a negative effect on the child in terms of...
- Their ability to adjust to large life changes
- Ability to cope with profound social adjustment
- The child becomes institutionalised as there are no significant changes from ages 3-18
- Removal of Milestone markers in a Childs development

What are the potential disadvantages if the proposal goes ahead?

Loss of school buildings in the centre of the Kenfig Hill area

I feel that this is an underrepresentation of this factor. Not only does it affect the school buildings which are historical to the local community, but the effects on the local community have been glazed over;

- Businesses will suffer due to loss of footfall
- There is a possibility of housing developments on these sites as is the trend throughout Bridgend County Borough (Appendix) which will also contribute negatively on the community;

Further traffic congestion
Strain on the local Doctor & Dental surgeries and other local amenities
The affect on the local hospital due to an increase in population
Strain on the proposed school due to an influx of new students/ families

There may be increased travel distance to the comprehensive site

Whilst conducting our Travel Survey we have found that most parents currently walk their children to school, should the relocation go ahead these parents have admitted they will be taking their cars; thus having a negative impact on the environment and on the Childs health. The parents who do not drive/ have a car/ car share with their spouse have all expressed that during adverse weather conditions they will not walk their child to school. This will lead to a large decline in attendance for the school.

Some parents may prefer to have their children educated at the existing school sites

This is the general opinion of most of the parents. However some parents expressed that the new school site is closer to their homes and for this reason they agree with the proposal.

Some parents may be concerned about primary aged pupils attending the same site as comprehensive pupils

This is the largest concern from ALL parents. And rightly so, during our research time we have come across a number of stories whereby the adolescent pupils of Cynffig Comprehensive have had a negative impact on the younger students of Mynydd Cynffig Infants and Juniors. One example is outlined below;

Friday 21.10.2016 - Cynffig Comprehensive had an inset day and therefore some of the pupils that attend that school congregated in the park adjacent to Mynydd Cynffig Juniors. Due to the behaviour of the teenagers, the staff of Mynydd Cynffig Juniors decided that it would be in the best interests of the younger pupils to keep them in during their break times. The behaviour exhibited by the teenagers was unacceptable for these younger pupils to witness and included; foul language, regular use of swear words, unacceptable hand gestures, smoking, sexual contact; heavy petting in public.

Pages 13 - 14

Alternatives

Option 1- Continue with the current arrangements with the school being run over two sites

This was discounted principally because this option is not sustainable, does not meet the strategy and aims of the authority as set out in the policy of 2006 for all through primary schools and would disadvantage future generations of learners by not addressing the need for 21st Century pupil places. The current school buildings have been categorised as Grade C (in poor condition) and the proposal would benefit learners by moving to a newly remodelled school suitable for the 21st Century.

 according to your own research on page 18 of the Consultation Document; Cynffig Comprehensive is also a Grade C building. Even with the plans to remodel the 6 form building to house the Primary Children, Cynffig Comprehensive will still remain a GRADE C building as we understand there will be no development/upgrade of the Comp itself?

Option 2- To provide additional accommodation at the Mynydd Cynffig Junior site to enable the transfer of pupils and closure of the Mynydd Cynffig Infant site

This was discounted principally because Highways have ongoing safety issues with the existing junior site and feel it would worsen with the development of the primary school on the site. Therefore, they would object to any planning application to further develop this site, due to serious concerns regarding highway safety.

- We as a collective group would like to see the surveys and a list of 'serious concerns' that
 Highways have given to rule that this site is no longer the preferred location for the Primary
 School We have had meetings with Tony from Highways and other than worries over
 congestion at the lights, there has been no forthcoming answer.
- In 2011 a report to cabinet confirmed that the Junior site was the preferred location. It ruled out the Infants and Comprehensive site.
- In 2015 whilst the council petitioned parents to amalgamate the schools to form a Primary School, the plans were relayed that the school would be located on the Junior Site - if parents had known that their children were to be relocated to the Comp, they would have denied the amalgamation.
- We as a collective feel that the only reason the Comprehensive has become the 'preferred site' is due to the 416 spaces it has to fill.

Concerns Raised Regarding the Proposed Plans to Cynffig Comprehensive Site

Our Concerns regarding the Proposed Site plans viewed during the consultation period at the Cynffig Comprehensive site on 08.11.2016 and again the 17.11.2016

 Interaction between the Primary and Comprehensive levels is inevitable during certain times, even though we addressed these issues during the meetings it is... and I quote "down to the School Management; meaning the head teachers to limit the interaction of the Primary and Comprehensive Pupils"

How can you limit these interactions when they will be sharing a site? Granted they are to be housed in different locations - but they are all sharing the same site. We have heard of some methods that will be implemented e.g.

Staggered start times and break times

In theory these ideas are great but when put into practise it will be too late to go back

E.g buses arrive at 8.15am - the same time that breakfast club starts; how will you stop them interacting?

Comp may start at 9am and Infants at 9.15am - parents that have children in the same location will drop them to school at the same time.

School facility sharing - there will inevitably be a crossover during these times as timetabling can only do so much.

- The Juniors playground is surrounded on 3 sides by a walkway that will be used by Comprehensive school students to gain access to their sports hall - what material will be used to construct this? Fencing will allow interaction between the age groups. Brick walls will make it feel like a prison.
- The promenade overlooks the proposed site for the nursery, with the grassed area surrounding it continuing to be used by Comprehensive pupils for leisure activities e.g. football.
- Shared facilities; which could not be divulged in any of the Proposal meetings as it was up to 'Educational Management' to arrange them once the school is in situ. The only one that 'may be' shared were the playing fields. However in their current Juniors and Infants sites there is no need to share these facilities.
- The new 6 form block is only approx 100ft from the new playground; within eye sight for most of the children.

- East avenue will still be used as a drop off point for students; however there will be added congestion.
- The Industrial Estate is already busy and dangerous with the use of articulated lorries and HGVs on a daily basis; also there is the additional factor of the new concrete factory (planning application can be found in this document) - which increases the traffic and the use of HGVs on the site.
- Our BIGGEST CONCERN is now the approved planning for a concrete factory to be added to the industrial estate adjacent to the athletics field and the impact it may have on the health of EVERY SINGLE CHILD in the local area.

Counter Proposal

We are currently investigating the Ownership of the land for both the Juniors and Infants site - we have been led to believe that both sites were donated by Mr Talbot of Margam Estate for Educational purposes and therefore neither belong to the council.

We as a collective group want it noted that we are opposed to the relocation of Mynydd Cynffig Primary to the Comprehensive site, but we are welcome to the idea of building an FE2 school on the site of the Juniors.

We are currently investigating this further with a local architect who has kindly donated some of his time to us for free to look over the Junior site We are currently contacting local surveyors who can come and take a cursory look at the grounds and advise us of his findings. This will not be an in depth survey as the council has undertaken, but a brief walk of the ground to ascertain whether a school could be built there.

From our finding so far we have ascertained the following:

- There is enough room on the Junior site to house a 2 storey L shaped building.
- We propose that the allotments and the park be relocated to the Infants site this allowing
 us to utilise the space for the new school (as per your original document 2011)
- The space that has been freed up from the allotments, walkway to the allotments and the
 park will be where the new school will be built; an L shaped school nearing the back of what
 is currently the allotments, up to the park entrance and as far down as the vegetable patch
 on the school we ahve been advised that the gradients in this area are gently sloping and
 would need minimal landscaping.
- Health and Safety allowing, the Juniors school will remain working until the build nears completion. The only adjustment to their current site would be fencing surrounding the yard to prevent children crossing into the building site and the loss of their grassed area (but they will maintain their school field)
- A new road will be put in for access from the entrance to Caer Wetral Cul de sac allowing Site access while the development goes ahead, once completed it will allow for staff parking behind the new building.
- Once the new build is completed the fence surrounding the yard will be removed and placed around the old school - meaning that the yard continues to be the yard for the new school.
- Due to the difference in gradients Steps will be added to so that the site of the old school allowing for access down to the yard (should they be needed) but the main walk way to the school yard would be from the gently sloping gradient located near the allotments.
- Regarding the lane access behind Pwyll Y Garth street that is currently used to drop off children; A portion of the school field will be taken away - allowing for a 2 lane road access and a pedestrian walkway.
- Once the build is complete the old school would be demolished and a turning circle will be located where the reception/ hall of the school is currently located.
- The playing field would remain where it is and the additional room made when the old building is removed would allow for external learning spaces.

- Cordon off/ bollard the lanes that lead from the school to Pwyll Y Garth Street, so that it protects pedestrians and does not allow through traffic.
- PLEASE BEAR IN MIND THAT THE INCREASE IN ROAD TRAFFIC WOULD NOT BE EXPEIRENCED
 OF THE SITE WAS LOCATED ON THE JUNIOR SITE AS MOST PARENTS WOULD CONTINUE TO
 WALK.

The counter proposal would be more beneficial as:

- There are multiple road routes leading from the Junior site, dispersing traffic quicker
- Parents would continue to walk their children to the site and that would prevent further congestion
- A portion of the Infants site would become available for sale for housing development (once the allotments and park were relocated)
- You could possibly look at selling some of the land that Cynffig Comprehensive school doesn't use as it was said in the proposal meetings there is too much land on this location.
- Footfall would continue past local businesses
- The community would be happy.







We would like the following points noted:

- 1. We have grave concerns regarding how much land is being taken from the Comprehensive School in order to accommodate the Primary School. There will be a considerable reduction in space for the Secondary School Pupils at break and lunch and for PE lessons.
- 2. The reduction in space will create congestion in one are as pupils will not have the space that they have previously had access to.
- 3. The positioning of the extension on Block 4 means there will be considerable difficulty in supervising and managing Comprehensive School Pupils. No resources at lunchtimes are being offered to support the Comprehensive School.
- 4. No proposals have been made/suggested to upgrade the Comprehensive Building. There will be a distinct difference between 2 sites on one campus. This might deter pupils in the Primary transitioning into Cynffig Comprehensive.
- 5. Safety & Wellbeing is a concern of Comprehensive Pupils with increased traffic down East Avenue in the mornings and at the end of the day. Even with staggered start and departure times there will be increased traffic and subsequent risks associated with this.
- 6. The Comprehensive School outside facilities are being reduced which surely is a dis benefit to their Health & Wellbeing. Existing School Playing fields will be reduced and in turn limiting future activities.
- 7. Safeguarding issues are intensified with increased footfall on the campus/site for health & safety reasons, healthy schools agenda.
- 8. There will be a carpark drop off area on the site. This is both a potential safeguarding and health and safety risk. How will the Comprehensive be supported to manage this.

Unfortunately I was unable to attend today and won't be able to make the one on the 8th (I work full time, and even if I didn't it still might not be possible as it's hard to be available at 4pm if you have children with you!) I know of a number of parents that cannot make these sessions as they don't finish work until 6pm. We would like a meeting, like the one held today, rather than individual drop in sessions as, I imagine, they are less intimidating for some. Also, we all have the same questions anyway so why meet separately? Could someone please look into offering an additional meeting for parents of both schools that are unable to attend at these early times? I think it would be a good idea to invite parents of other feeder schools to Cynffig Comprehensive too as their children will undoubtedly be affected if the main benefit sought is to ease transition between KS2 and KS3. Will the full information that was shared with attendees this evening be available for viewing before we arrange our own meetings if BCBC decide they don't want to offer additional evenings (it's quite an important consultation though so I can't imagine what would stop you wanting to talk with as many residents and staff as possible). Also, which other schools like this have you visited? If you could let me know of them I would like to contact them too and help arrange visits for those parents that could visit. What will the main ethos be? What are the shared values? Will each school still receive their individual government (council) payments or is this to be shared? Have the change in catchment boundaries that Porthcawl wanted to introduce been taken into consideration? (Not sure if this advanced further from the message that was passed on to parents visiting an open evening 3 years ago!) I do have a lot of questions, not just negative comments, that need answering and a lot of information / evidence regarding the positive outcomes of such schools. I don't know if the Donaldson review quite meant full on 3-18 year schools when talking about a pathway through education! Can't wait to hear from you, thanks!



R.E: Mynydd Cynffig Primary Relocation Proposals



After viewing the relevant documents for the proposed relocation of Mynydd Cynffig Primary School, I would like to submit my views and concerns about the consultation document and plans submitted. I would be grateful if these views could be shared with all the relevant parties before they get to make a decision on the school's future.

I'd like to start by highlighting the fact that at present Mynyndd Cynffig Primary is providing a good education to the pupils that attend the school. The school is well managed and any argument put across that a move is needed to enhance the education of the pupils is factually incorrect. The school's data is above the national average and in recent inspections (as Infant and Juniors) the schools were graded as good and excellent. The school doesn't need relocating for 21st century learning to take place as it already takes places in lessons every single day. Estyn praised many aspects of 21st Century learning in their inspection reports and the school wouldn't achieve such good results if this wasn't the case.

There are issues with the location of the current sites (Infants/Juniors) in regards to car parking however this is the case at almost every school in Wales. I feel the purpose plans wouldn't improve the current problem but instead make it worse for parents to take their children to school and cause more safety concerns. Where primary education differs to secondary education is that parents and guardians park their cars and like to take their children into school and wait with their children until it is time to go into school. As a result of this traffic/parking is very busy at Commercial Street (Infant site) and

t (Junior site) at the start and end of the school day. The also have the same trouble on their access road East Avenue which is often grid locked because the two way road only has room for one car due to the fact that cars are parked along the narrow street. If the seine school was to move to the comprehensive site, some of the traffic from winygam St. and Commercial Street would then start to access East Avenue and this road would not support the increased volume of traffic and parking. On a rainy day potentially an <u>additional</u> 300 plus cars could attempt to access East Avenue if they choose not to drive out of their way to the Industrial est. entrance. I would suggest you visit East Avenue before the start of the school day before making any decision.

I have concerns to the purposed solution to this problem, as you are aware there is a proposed 52 spaces parking zone for parents to use which can be accessed via Kenfig Ind. Est. Once the 52 spaces are full where will parents park? The answer to this is they will either have to drive back up to East Avenue or park on the roads in the nearby Industrial Estate. Children will then have to cross roads used by mainly large vehicles such as heavy lorries. They will also have to cross the road that is accessed by all the school buses. Any driver error resulting in a collision with a lorry/bus will more than certainly result in fatalities. Larger vehicles will have increased difficulties spotting any children stepping out from behinds cars. The location of this parking bay is also out of people's way with an increased journey time. Many parents will still use the East Avenue entrance as it is human nature to use the nearest entrance especially if they are in a rush like most people are in the mornings.

My next concern is in regards to the planning application to build a concrete factory next to the proposed primary site. If approved this would cause serious health issues to all members who attend the relocated primary and comprehensive school. http://www.hse.gov.uk/lung-disease/cement-concrete-manufacture.htm states some of the effects from exposure to cement particles that would be present if a cement factory was located near the school. They state that "the short term, exposure to high levels of cement dust irritates the nose and throat. Longer term exposure could lead to occupational asthma. Mortar can also contain respirable crystalline silica (RCS).

RCS is also found in concrete and can lead to the development of silicosis or scarring of the lungs, which results in a loss of lung function and severe shortness of breath. Exposure to high concentrations can lead to death. If the planning is accepted along with the relocation of the primary school, this would pose serious health issues to all attending the school. Pupils would not have this potential risk in their current location.

My next concern is in regards to younger children being around the older children. Some older children often smoke, use bad language, and have discussions of a sexual nature which would be impossible to stop due to freedom of speech. I do not want my daughters aged 3 and 6 seeing and hearing these convertions school especially at such a young age. The age difference also increases the likelihood of pupils being sexually assaulted, even though this is slim. Recently past pupil Karanger who attended Cynffig Comprehensive was put on the sex offenders register for possessing images of young children on his computer, so there is a need to raise this concern, there is a risk added. Other stories of this nature do occur in the news where teenagers have sexually assaulted younger children and locating a primary to the Comprehensive site does add this additional safety concern. The Swindon advertiser reports an example of this

http://www.swindonadvertiser.co.uk/news/14680217.Teenager_denies_charges_of_sexually_assaulting_child/. At present pupils do not have this risk in their current location.

Another concern I have about having the school on one site is it takes away the transition from school to school. Transition is an important life lesson, we all go through changes in our lives such as going to college/university, change jobs, promotions etc. and it is important to experiences these changes. As a teacher myself I find some children are nervous about going to a new school but after experiencing the change learn that there wasn't anything early worry about. From learning this they are more confident when future changes occur in their lives as they can refer back to this experience. I think this is an important life lesson for children and it would be a shame for them to lose this experience.

My final concern is regarding the proposed location of the majority of the infants and junior classrooms. These will be based in a similar Grade C

building but the three story layout accessed by stair cases. Stair cases are not safe places for young children who regularly have trips and falls on flat playgrounds due to their coordination not being as developed older comprehensive pupils. At break times children are eager to be the first out to play and this can cause pushing and running which in turn is very dangerous when going down or up a flight of staircases. Also in the event of a fire it would also be much harder to get younger children out of the building which is made up of three stories. These risks are not an issue at their current locations.

I think it would be an excellent idea for the decision makers to visit both the current primary sites and see what a fantastic education the pupils are currently receiving in a safe and engaging learning environment the pupils are praised and reported on first hand. If they do this, they would see there is no need to relocate the two sites and endange the ty with the many factors I have included in this letter. Pupils safety should be the number one priority and this should never be compromised, pupils are achieving above the expected levels just the way things are. A simple solution to the problem of too many pupils would be to build a classroom extension on each primary sites and for the schools to carry on as they are doing a fantastic job. Each primary site have enormous playgrounds currently bigger than the proposed new playground at the comprehensive site. The majority of the parents do not want these plans to go ahead and have the same views as myself. Thank you for taking the time to read my concerns on the proposed move.

I have a child in nursery there and have lived in Kenfig Hill all my life, there are many reasons why I object to this, including;

I do not think it is suitable to have children from age 3-18 on the same site, even though for now they will be separately run schools it is still the same site, during the consultation meetings it was brought up that start times would be staggered for primary and comprehensive pupils by 30-45 minutes but this would be total for parents with children in both schools and the added issues with breakfast and after school clubs.

I live and dlands Park and if I walk along 'the line' at lunch time I find it quite intimidating walking through a group of comprehensive pupils and as this would be the way I would have to walk my contact and attended school, intimidated as an adult imagine how she, a 3 year old, would feel everyday.

I think the proposed site being the sixth form block is totally unsuitable for primary aged children, there are several flights of stairs and having gone there myself I know it is not a very child friendly environment. I also feel for the sixth formers losing their block as it is a right of passage to have your own space when you reach sixth form.

The relocation will encourage many more people to drive cather than alk to school as if you live at the top of Kenfig Hill it is too far to walk with a child/children. As we are all being encouraged to move more and protect our environment this cannot be a good thing for anyone.

Safety is another issue that needs to be addressed; East Avenue and Meadow Avenue are already very dangerous at school times with the amount of cars dropping off so this problem is likely to significantly increas adding primary aged children to the mix. Thank you to you and your colleagues for answering so many of the questions I asked on Thursday. I did leave feeling more aware of the proposed changes and the reasons why. There were some you weren't able to answer at the time as, quite fairly, you didn't know at the time. And there are a couple of others that I wanted to ask / clarify. I'll see if I can remember them!

- The concrete brick making factory; how and who will monitor it to ensure it meets health and safety regulations? Also how close is it to the school?
- The relocation of Tythegston tip; why does it need to be moved and why to Pyle Industrial Estate? Where on the estate would it be and what would be the effect on the school if it did move?
- -The drop off point is still a big concern for parents. Would a car park be feasible? However, I am aware of the way parents currently park at the tow sites. When the highways management looked at this was the combined volume of traffic along with possible increase, considered?

How can parents be persuaded not to drop children off at the pedestrian entrance?

- What will happen to the infant site? You did state that you the state of site would be sold off and that most likely more housing would be built. I think parents would be more pliable if they knew they would benefit in some way from the relocation.
- Safe journeys to school patrolled crossing etc? Will there be any?

I think one of the biggest problems has been that many parents believe this is going to be a Super School not 2 schools on 2 separate sites. I was hoping to speak to Mr Davies and see if I could organise a meeting with parents to share the information I have received from you.

I do think there are things that could be taken into consideration that would make it more appealing to parents: comprehensive finishing before primary to help with school pick ups but starting at least half an hour beforehand to avoid the 2 school walking in together. And there would have to be plenty of outside space for the pupils of the transfer and don't think many parents/carers are aware of the funding planned to improve the 2 schools to the transfer and the transfer rightly?) for all the pupils and staff.

People are afraid of change and don't often hear everything being told. And I imagine it's a lot for people to take in as the 2 schools hold many memories for those that went there.

Apologies, I seem to have gone on or a tangent our lopefully I am making some sense! I know that the deadline is tomorrow but answers to the questions would still be much appreciated as I could share with other parents.




I whole heatedly disagree with the plans to relocate Mynydd Cynffig Primary. Here are some of the

reasons why.

As much as we are being reassured our children won't come into contact with comprehensive pupils, by your own admission you can not guarantee this. It is my opinion that there will be contact on routes to and from school, even if there are staggered start/finish times. We need to take into account pupils going to breakfast clubs and after school clubs. Also according to your plans the playground areas are in view of the comprehensive children

age school They have always been brilliant Moving them so for away from the Centre! our village would be awful for our area, for Our community and maybe even for our beat!



Lets face it, the proposed site is only just in catchment area! I would have to drive out of the Village to get to it. There would be a long walk to this school for smaller children, not pleasant for any parent thrying to get, for example, a 3+5 year old to school in the rain. I walk to school every day but in all honesty this change would make me take my car.

As for the transition to comp then being easier for our children, I don't agree. I think that the bigger step up is better for them. That they learn to grow and adapt in that time helping them to mature and

be ready for that time ahead.

Things like kerboraft and the cycling programme will be made more difficult. East Ave or the Industrial Estate are hardly appropriate. The roads around the comprehensive are already highly congested at school times, East Ave, Meadows Ave, Tytalwyn Ave will surely be affected

ever with the alternative access route through
fyle industrial estate People won't necessarily

choose the furthest route.

So that leads us to the new access via Pyle and est. It shocks me that under the guidelines you follow, this is deemed a suitable walking route for our infant children. In terms of traffic, if I choose this route I am effectively in the next village. The indest is congested at the best of times. This will be hugely added to if this plan goes ahead.

People I know are already talking about moving their children from the school if this goes ahead. I would also like to know why there is such a change from the existing proposals made in Tune down Our area hasn't changed. Mynydd Lynffig Tunior school is then clearly the preferred

site. There were no concerns over the size of the land. Reasons given now state that Highways

would object, yet in 2011 the findings were supported and sympathetic consideration was to be given the proposal. None of this adds up. Hease either build on the junior site or keep the existing schools as they are and use some of your budget for upgrade and repairs. The amalgamation of the infant and junior schools to become a himany was supported but we were led to believe that when we would become one school it would be on the junior site. Obviously this wasn't plan promised, but we were definitely told it was the preferred site. We did not envisage what was to come. Had we done, I feel this would not have been supported. Please don't ruin our village.
