

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
THE BRIDGEND TOWN CENTRE (ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES) ORDER (No.1) 2008

Bridgend County Borough Council ("the Council") hereby makes the following Order under section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 ("the Act"):

1. The land described in the Schedule below and plan annexed thereto being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Act applies, will be designated for the purposes of the Act.
2. This Order may be cited as the **THE BRIDGEND TOWN CENTRE (ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES) ORDER (No.1) 2008** and shall come into force on 1st December 2008.

Under Regulation 5(c) the local authority hereby identifies that Section 14(1B) of the Act applies to the Bridgend Recreation Centre which prevents the premises from being, or being part of, a designated public place only

- (a) at times when it is being used for the sale or supply of alcohol; and
- (b) at times falling within 30 minutes after the end of a period during which it has been so used.

And this shall apply to any premises temporarily licensed under a Temporary Event Notice, such as for a street party or other special event, or where the premises licence is held by the Council, or is occupied by or managed on its behalf and covered by a premises licence held by a third party.

A place is not a designated public place or part of such a place if it is:

- (a) premises in respect of which a premises licence has effect which authorises the premises to be used for the sale or supply of alcohol
- (b) premises in respect of which a club premises certificate has effect which certifies that the premises may be used by the club for the sale or supply of alcohol
- (c) places that are within the curtilage of premises with a premises licence or club premises certificate
- (d) premises that are the subject of a Temporary Event Notice
- (e) premises permitted for the sale or consumption of alcohol under Section 115E of the Highways Act 1980

The Order covers highways and public areas as well as areas in private ownership to which members of the public have access including car parks, doorways, forecourts and arcades.

The effect of this Order is to designate specific areas in the County Borough of Bridgend as described in the Schedule below. In these areas any person who continues drinking intoxicating liquor in a designated area when asked to desist by a Police Officer under section 12(2)(a) of the Act or fails to surrender any intoxicating liquor in his/her possession

when asked to do so by a Police Officer under section 12(2)(b) of the Act commits an offence as follows:

Any person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed on them under Section 12(2) of the Act commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £500 [Section 12(4) of the Act].
